About the college

GDC Bishnah is about 25 kms away towards south from the main city of Jammu and covers about 137 adjoining villages having a total population of about 2.5 to 3.0 lakh, approximately. The college was initiated with an encouraging strength of 159 students covering both male and female in the very first academic session 2008-09 and touched the strength of 519 over the last ten academic years.

The college is presently running only Arts stream with 11 subjects covering fifteen subject combinations with emphasis on activities and conscious effort to attract and retain talented students through permanent talented

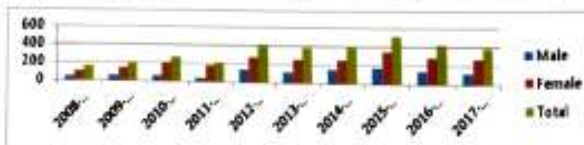

Govt. Degree College is functioning in the premises of Govt. Hr. Secondary School (Boys) Bishnah since its inception in 2008 into and its available infrastructural facility are as under:-

Library

The college has a Developing library to facilitate students for extra reading. To keep the students updated with current affairs and general knowledge, the college provides a viable and regular collection of magazines, Journals, national & local newspapers. The college has installed an internet broadband connection in the library to update the knowledge of students and teaching faculty. Books are issued to the students on the production of the library-borrower-cards duly authenticated by Principal which is issued to him/her at the beginning of each academic session by the librarian. The students are required to observe the following library rules:

- ❖ The College library is open for students and staff from 9 a.m to 3 p.m on all working days. Students are allowed to get issued only two book at a time which has to be returned within 7 days failing which a fine of Rs. 1 per day is charged.
- ❖ Complete silence is to be observed in the college library.
- ❖ Students are directed to handle books properly. Anybody found misusing the library books/library journals/ magazines will be punished under rules.

- ◆ If a borrowed book is lost or spoiled, the students responsible for it will be liable to replace it or pay double the cost of the book.
- ◆ Photostat Facility: Photostat facility is also provided in the library section of the college for the students on "No Profit No Loss basis", which shall provide the students access within the college premises at lowest possible price as fixed by the college authorities.
- ◆ The college authorities has been making all effort to modernize the library to meet the contemporary needs by involving recent technological advancements.
- ◆ Students appearing for University examination shall surrender their library card before getting roll number slips.

Identity Card

1. Every student on being admitted shall be issued an identity card" which he/she will carry at all times and shall produce on demand while in college.
2. The loss of identity card should be reported immediately.
3. Duplicate card may be issued after proper verification against payment of Rs. 100.
4. Identity cards must be returned at the end of each session failing which an amount of Rs. 200/- shall be charged.

Internet Library & Computer Lab

The College has registered itself to the Infibnet centre, ahmedabad, which can help students to browse through about 52,000 books and journals on the internet. The college provides the students with username and password on the production of the identity card. This shall help the student to keep pace with the ever changing & dynamic cyber world lying in front of them. The college has provided the students two computers sanctioned by National Mission on education under Information & Communication Technology. For this purpose, all are installed with broadband connections to update & increase their mental horizon in this era of sheer competition.



NSS WING

NSS unit comprising 100 volunteers is running in the college under the stewardship of experienced programme officer, for inculcating the true moral values among students and they are encouraged to participate actively in the scheme to foster love and passion for humanity, brotherhood and selfless



service for the mankind. The NSS wing is going to initiate a summer internship programme on Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan of 100 hours awarding 2 credits under U.G.C sponsored courses.

Red Ribbon club

The College has created a Red Ribbon Club in collaboration with J&K State AIDS Prevention & Control Society, Department of Health and Medical Education for the dissemination of information regarding the prevention of HIV and AIDS through various AIDS awareness programme instituted by the Health Department within as well as outside the college premises. This shall equip the students in particular and the society in general about the relevant information to keep them insulated from this deadly disease.



NCC WING

The National Cadet Corps in India is a voluntary organization that involves students in adventurous activities. NCC Girls unit has been allotted to the College which inculcates values of Patriotism, Leadership, courage and Discipline. NCC also helps the cadets in seeking Jobs in Police, paramilitary and defence forces.



Department of sports

The College has a department of sports and games to promote among the students the qualities of sportsmanship and to tap the nascent talent lying among the students of the area. The Department has good lot of sports material for meeting the true requirements of various sports activities in which students are continuously encouraged to participate including inter-collegiate as well national tournament/competition from time to time. Special emphasis is given to overall development personality through various practice sessions held in the college before participating in actual event. The college has produced many sports person who brought laurels by winning various sports competitions.



College spared no stone returned to train the college youth for sports activities through the dedicated team of staff members working for the cause. The college has bagged 2 Silver, 1 bronze Medals in women wrestling, 2 Gold Medals in Men wrestling, 2 Silver Medals in Men Athletics and Boxing in 2017-18.



Grievance cell

Grievance Cell is constituted in the college to address genuine difficulties faced by students.

Career counselling cell

A career Counselling Cell has been constituted under the dynamic supervision of the staff, aware of the contemporary changes taking place in the surrounding world of career opportunities to help the students to pursue a particular career option for their livelihood, thereby building a dynamic and confident society.



Development Centre

To strengthen gender sensitization among students and teachers, a Women Development Cell is constituted in the college. The main objective of the cell is to understand the gender as a social construct and recognize the multidimensional roles played by women. Since the college is located in the rural set up, the main focus, therefore, remains to make the women aware of their rights regarding health and literacy.

College Bus

Our college Bus provides an additional facility to the students coming from remote villages so that every student after passing 12th class get enrolled and avail the benefit of higher education with zero dropout. A committee is constituted in which the students are the part in framing modalities for the smooth functioning of this transport facility at concessional rates from College to adjoining village of Allah, Pindi, Shibuchak to make the reach of the students and safe comfortable.



Medical Dispensary

To ensure the availability of basic medical facilities for the students, a small medical Aid Dispensary is functioning under the supervision of an experienced pharmacist. This dispensary maintains a necessary stock of medicines and other related items for First Aid.

ANTI-ragging cell

As per the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, University of Jammu and Department of Higher Education, an anti-ragging cell has been established in the college to curb the menace of ragging in any form, on or off the college campus by establishing it as cognizable offence. Students indulging in this practice will be severely punished, which can include explanation and expulsion from the college.

Picnic And Subject Tour



Picnic of the college is generally organized in the first week of February. This is an academic exercise which makes the students familiar with social and cultural heritage of the adjoining areas and state. The college also organises field trips in the subject Environmental Science to acquaint the students regarding, natural environment.

Admission Process

The college offers three year Degree Programme in Bachelor of Arts, stream only, the examination of which is conducted by University of Jammu. The admission to B.A. Sem-I, III & V shall be made open on the dates notified by University of Jammu.

The application/Pre-admission form for selection is to be submitted on the prescribed Application Form attached herewith. On selection, candidates will be required to fill in the prescribed admission Form and submit it along with the required documents and admission Fee before the last date with the College Admission committee.

a) General Rules for Admission

1. A Student who has passed Higher Secondary Part II examination (class 12th) of the J&K Board of School Education or an Examination recognized as its equivalent by the University of Jammu and hailing from Jammu district is eligible for admission to B.A. Sem-I of three year Degree Course.

- The wards of State or Central Govt. Employees posted in Jammu district can be given admission subject availability seats.
- Students from Institutions located within the territorial jurisdiction of the University of Jammu and the University of Kashmir as residents of state will have preference in admission over non-resident students who have passed Higher Secondary Part-II examination from Institutions falling under the Jurisdiction of J&K Board of School Education. The latter will be given admission subject to the availability seats.
- A student whose result is declared late by the State Board may be admitted as per admission statuses of Jammu University subject to the availability of seats.
- A student who is admitted to the college and completes the minimum required attendance but either fails or does not appear in the ensuing University examination, will not be considered for admission in the same class again.
- A student with a break in academic career will not be considered for admission in the college. However, the Principal may condone one year break in case of students where he feels convinced about the reasons leading to the break in studies.
- If a student after being admitted remains continuously absent for 14 days, He/she shall be removed from the college rolls and shall not be readmitted to the same class during the same year. The year so wasted shall be counted as a year of break and dealt with under appropriate clauses, if he/she presents himself/herself for readmission during, the same year. The year so wasted shall be counted as a year of break and dealt with under appropriate clauses, if he/she presents himself/herself for readmission during the next year.
- No applicant for B.A. Sem- I can take up Mathematics as a subject unless he has qualified the higher Secondary Part II or equivalent examination with Mathematics as one of the subjects.
- Change of subject is not permitted in B.A. Sem-III or B.A. Sem V. As per GGM Science college notification the scheduled for the admission to B. A. Sem. 1st session 2018-19 as under:-

Evaluation system of the College

Examination aims at evaluating and judging student's knowledge in a specific time frame and analyzing whether students have gone through a certain course of study satisfactorily. Test enables, the teacher to know how well students have understood the subject. Teacher's dedication towards his profession is judged through examination and the efforts of teachers are awarded when students pass in the examination.

The evaluation process of all classes are strictly observed and conducted as per the university norms and it is carried out by the examination committee of the college under the supervision of the Head of the institution. The examination committee of the college works on following lines:

- a) It frames a consolidated date sheet of Internal Examination of all classes, gets the question papers (two sets) prepared from teacher concerned and gets one selected for test strictly as per university pattern.
- b) Committee also facilitates the process of the smooth conduct of the internal practical tests carried out by the respective Departments.
- c) At the end of the session, internal assessment awards of theory and practical along with the awards of attendance of every student after its checking by the inspection team appointed by the university are tabulated on award roll sheets for its onward transmission to the controller of examination, University of Jammu.
- d) College examination cell strictly maintain the sanctity of the annual university examinations.

Examination

The semester/annual examination in each course is conducted by the University of Jammu in March/April/May. College has three Examination Centres with the intake capacity of 350 students only.

Marks for Internal Assessment Test

1) In case of Semester System

- a) In theory 20% of total marks of each subject are assigned for internal assessment tests. These marks are spread in the form of one home assignment and class test of 10 marks each and students are required to attain minimum 75% attendance in theory so as to become eligible for university final examinations.

In Case of Annual System

- b) 20% of total marks for each theory paper in a subject are reserved for internal assessment test each subject carries 15 marks assigned through two class tests each of 7.5 marks each and remaining 5 marks are calculated on the basis of the regularity of the attendance. The marks for attendance are awarded on the basis of the following scale:-

Up to 75% of the total number of attendance	Zero
Above 75% to 80% of the total number of attendance	40%
Above 80% to 85% of the total number of attendance	60%
Above 85% to 90% of the total number of attendance	80%
Above 90% of the total number of attendance	100%

- 2) Student obtaining attendance less than 75% of the total lecture delivered will be debarred from appearing university semester examination.
- 3) Similarly, in practical 50% of the total marks are with the teacher who evaluates the student's performance in the laboratory. These marks are spread over in the form of 05 marks for attendance, 08 marks for internal practical test and 12 marks are for daily evaluation of the students by the teacher in the form of . . .
- 4) Students are required to perform at least 15 Practicals and must gained minimum of 75% of attendance out of total lectures delivered by the teacher.

Certificates issued to the outgoing students

An outgoing student may obtain the following certificate from the college:-

- a. Provisional Certificate.
- b. Character Certificate
- c. College leaving Certificate (if student leaves in mid-session)
- d. Certificate of having appeared in the University Examination.

Scholarship & Financial Assistance:- Scholarships are granted by social welfare deptt. And other agencies to the students belonging to following categories:-

1. Scheduled caste / Scheduled tribe scholarship.
2. Backward caste scholarship.
3. National / Merit cum Means scholarship.
4. College provides financial assistance to students belonging to economically/Backward / broken families/physical handicapped/ Orphan students.

The Grant & Continuance of the scholarship is subject to the following conditions:-

1. Regular Attendance.
2. Satisfactory Conduct.
3. Production of Income Certificate, Other Certificates as & when required.
4. Attested copy of State Subject Certificate.
5. Applications for the grant of the scholarship are duly scrutinized by a committee of teachers who recommend the deserving cases to the Principal.

Students applying for the Scholarships are required to submit the following particulars:

1. Father's/Guardians name and occupation.
2. Certificate of Income of the Father/Guardian.
3. Attested copy of State Subject certificate.
4. Testimonial, if any.
5. The income certificate of the Father/Guardian should be issued & certified by the revenue officer not less than the rank of a Tehsildar. Scholarship of students who don't show satisfactory academic progress will be reduced or stopped as the case may be.

College Discipline Committee

The college spares no effort to inculcate especially moral discipline among the students through our experienced and dedicated staff members.

General Rules

- A student desirous of withdrawing his/her name from the college rolls should submit an application, countersigned by the parent/guardian of the student. The withdrawal candidate shall in no case be readmitted during the same academic session.
- Any student who indulges in any indiscipline in the college shall not be eligible for any prize certificate, award or scholarship from the institution.
- Students shall not leave the college premises during the working hours except with the permission of Principal and teacher incharge Discipline Committee.
- Ragging in any form, on or off the college Campus is a cognizable offence and the student indulging in this practice will be severely punished, which can include explanation and expulsion from the college.

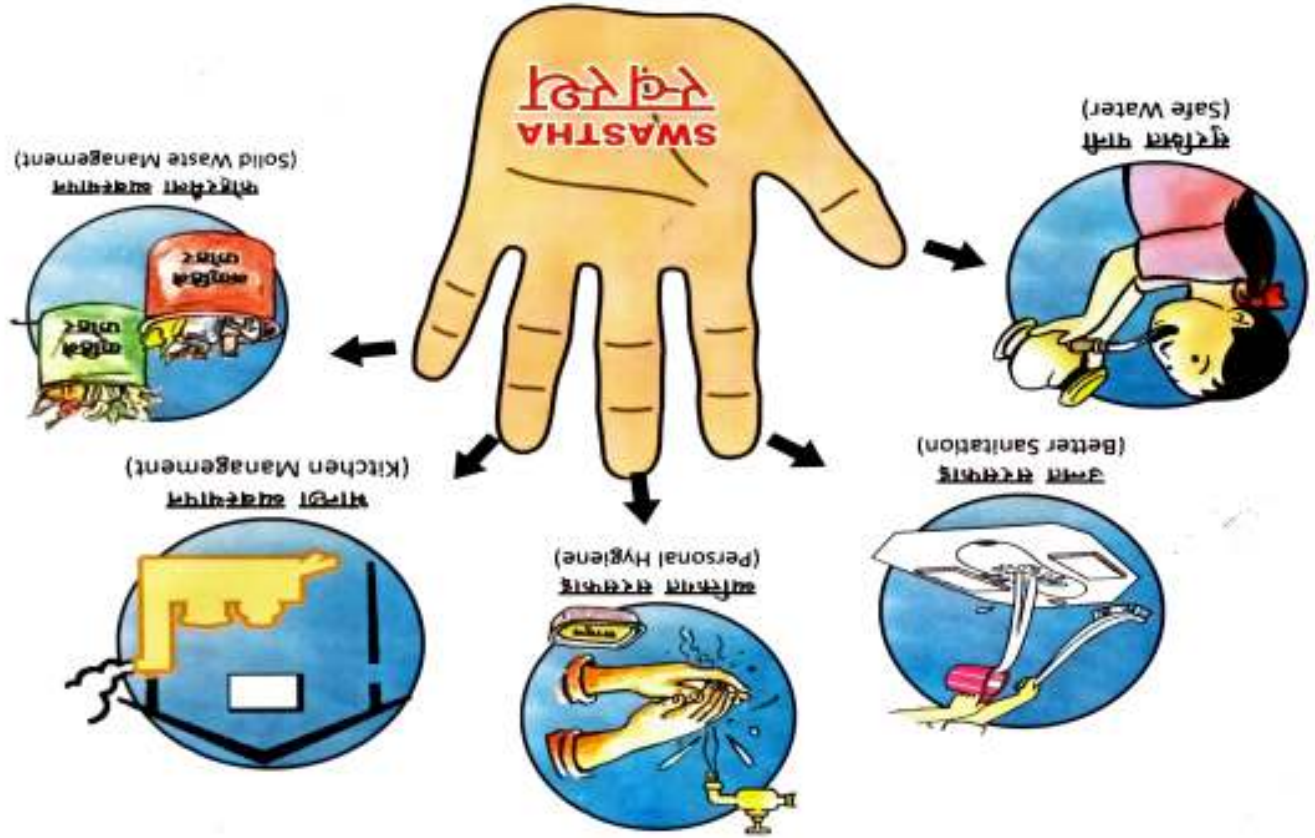

The college is presently running only Arts stream with 11 subjects covering fifteen subject combinations with emphasis on activities and conscious effort to attract and retain talented students through persistent talented

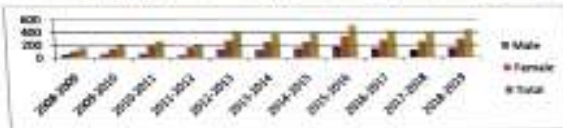

Books are issued to the students on the production of the library-membership-cards duly authenticated by Principal which is issued to him/her at the beginning of each academic session by the librarian. The students are required to observe the following library rules:

- The College library is open for students and staff from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on all working days. Students are allowed to get issued only two book at a time which has to be returned within 7 days failing which a fine of Rs. 1 per day is charged.
- Complete silence is to be observed in the college library.
- Students are directed to handle books properly. Anybody found misusing the library books/library journals/magazines will be punished under rules.

- If a borrowed book is lost or spoiled, the students responsible for it will be liable to replace it or pay double the cost of the book.
- Photostat Facility: Photostat facility is also provided in the library section of the college for the students on "No Profit No Loss basis", which shall provide the students access within the college premises at lowest possible price as fixed by the college authorities.
- The college authorities has been making all effort to modernize the library to meet the contemporary needs by involving recent technological advancements.
- Students appearing for University examination shall surrender their library card before getting roll number slips.

IDENTITY CARD

1. Every student on being admitted shall be issued an identity card" which he/she will carry at all times and shall produce on demand while in college.
2. The loss of identity card should be reported immediately.
3. Duplicate card maybe issued after proper verification against payment of Rs. 100.
4. Identity cards must be returned at the end of each session failing which an amount of Rs. 200- shall be charged.

INTERNET LIBRARY & COMPUTER LAB

The College has registered itself to the INFLIBNET CENTRE, AHMEDABAD, which can help students to browse through books and journals on the internet. The college provides the students with username and password on the production of the identity card. This shall help the student to keep pace with the ever changing & dynamic cyber world lying in front of them. The college has provided the students two computers sanctioned by National Mission on education under Information & Communication Technology. For this purpose, all are installed with broadband connections to update & increase their mental horizon in this era of sheer competition.

GRIEVANCE CELL

Grievance Cell has been constituted in the college under the chairmanship of principal and headed by the senior faculty Dr. Seema Juyal Associate Professor of Political Science to address all kind of complaints, problems and difficulties faced by students.

CAREER COUNSELLING CELL

A career Counselling Cell has been constituted under the dynamic supervision of the staff, aware of the contemporary changes taking place in the surrounding world of career opportunities to help the students to pursue a particular career option for their livelihood, thereby building a dynamic and confident society.



DEVELOPMENT CENTRE

To strengthen gender sensitization among students and teachers, a Women Development Cell is constituted in the college.

The main objective of the cell is to understand the gender as a social construct and recognize the multidimensional roles played by women. Since the college is located in the rural set up, the main focus, therefore, remains to make the women aware of their rights regarding health and literacy.



COLLEGE BUS

Our college bus provides an additional facility to the students coming from remote villages so that every student after passing 12th class get enrolled and avail the benefit of higher education with zero dropout. A committee is constituted in which the students are the part it in framing modalities for the smooth functioning of this transport facility at concessional rates from College to adjoining village of Allah, Pindi, Shubochak to make the reach of the students and safe comfortable.



MEDICAL DISPENSARY

To ensure the availability of basic medical facilities for the students, a small medical Aid Dispensary is functioning under the supervision of an experienced pharmacist Mr. Sunil Kumar. This dispensary maintains a necessary stock of medicines and other related items required for First Aid.

ANTI-RAGGING CELL

As per the provisions of the state anti-ragging law, the ragging is completely banned and whosoever, directly or indirectly commits or participate in or abets or propagates ragging within or outside any education institution will, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years or fined or both. Also as per the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, University of Jammu and Department of Higher Education Department (J&K), an anti-ragging cell has been established in the college to curb the menace of ragging in any form, on or off the college campus by establishing it as cognizable offence. Students indulging in this practice will be severely punished, which can include explanation and expulsion from the college.

PICNIC AND SUBJECT TOUR

Picnic of the college is generally organized in the first week of February. This is an academic exercise which makes the students familiar with social and cultural heritage of the adjoining areas and state. The college also organises field trips in the subject Environmental Science to acquaint the students regarding natural environment.



ADMISSION PROCESS

The college offers three year Degree Programme in Bachelor of Arts, stream only, the examination of which is conducted by University of Jammu. The admission to B.A. Sem-I, III & V shall be made open on the dates notified by University of Jammu.

The application/Pre-admission form for selection is to be submitted on the prescribed Application Form attached herewith. On selection, candidates will be required to fill in the prescribed admission Form and submit it along with the required documents and admission Fee before the last date with the College Admission committee in person.

a) General Rules for Admission

1. Admission is opened to every state subject and children of Central Govt. Employees posted in J&K State.
2. A Student who has passed Higher Secondary Part II examination (class 12th) of the J&K Board of School Education or an Examination recognized as its equivalent by the University of Jammu and hailing from Jammu district is eligible for admission to B.A. Sem-I of three year Degree Course.
3. Students from Institutions located within the territorial jurisdiction of the University of Jammu and the University of Kashmir as residents of state will have preference in admission over non-resident students who have passed Higher Secondary Part-II examination from Institutions falling under the Jurisdiction of J&K Board of School Education. The latter will be given admission subject to the availability of seats.
4. A student whose result is declared late by the State Board may be admitted provisionally as per admission statutes of Jammu University subject to the availability of seats.
5. A student who is admitted to the college and completes the minimum required attendance but either fails or does not appear in the ensuing University examination, will not be considered for admission in the same class again.
6. A student with a break in academic career will not be considered for admission in the college. However, the Principal may condone one year break in case of students where he feels convinced about the reasons leading to the break in studies.
7. If a student after being admitted remains continuously absent for 14 days. He/she shall be removed from the college rolls and shall not be readmitted to the same class during the same year. The year so wasted shall be counted as a year of break and dealt with under appropriate clauses, if he/she presents himself/herself for readmission during, the same year or next year.

EVALUATION SYSTEM OF THE COLLEGE

Examination aims at evaluating and judging student's knowledge in a specific time frame and analyzing whether students have gone through a certain course of study satisfactorily. Test enables, the teacher to know how well students have understood the subject. Teacher's dedication towards his profession is judged through examination and the efforts of teachers are awarded when students pass in the examination.

The evaluation process of all classes are strictly observed and conducted as per the university norms

and it is carried out by the examination committee of the college under the supervision of the Head of the institution. The examination committee of the college works on following lines.

- It frames a consolidated date sheet of Internal Examination of all classes, gets the questions papers (two sets) prepared from teacher concerned and gets one selected for test strictly as per university pattern.
- Committee also facilitates the process of the smooth conduct of the internal practical tests carried out by the respective Departments.
- At the end of the session, internal assessment awards of theory and practical along with the awards of attendance of every student after its checking by the inspection team appointed by the university are tabulated on award roll sheets for its onward transmission to the controller of examination, University of Jammu.
- College examination cell strictly maintains the sanctity of the annual university examinations.

EXAMINATION

The semester annual examination in each course is conducted by the University of Jammu in March/April/May. College has basic Examination Centres with the intake capacity of 150 students only.

MARKS FOR INTERNAL ASSESSMENT TEST

- In case of Semester System**
 - In theory 20% of total marks of each subject are assigned for internal assessment tests. These marks are spread in the form of one home assignment and class test of 10 marks each and students are required to attain minimum 75% attendance in theory so as to become eligible for university final examinations.
- In case of Annual System**
 - 30% of total marks for each theory paper in a subject are reserved for internal assessment test each subject carries 15 marks assigned through two class tests each of 7.5 marks each and remaining 5 marks are calculated on the basis of the regularity of the attendance. The marks for attendance are awarded on the basis of the following scale:-

Up to 75% of the total number of attendance	Zero
Above 75% to 80% of the total number of attendance	40%
Above 80% to 85% of the total number of attendance	60%
Above 85% to 90% of the total number of attendance	80%
Above 90% of the total number of attendance	100%

- Student obtaining attendance less than 75% of the total lectures delivered will be debarred from appearing university semester examination.
- Similarly, in practical 50% of the total marks are with the teacher who evaluates the student's performance in the laboratory. These marks are spread over in the form of 05 marks for attendance, 08 marks for internal practical test and 12 marks are for daily evaluation of the students by the teacher in the form of \square , B & Y.
- Students are required to perform at least 15 Practicals and must gained minimum of 75% of attendance out of total lectures delivered by the teacher.

CERTIFICATES ISSUED TO THE OUTGOING STUDENTS

An outgoing student may obtain the following certificate from the college:-

- Professional Certificate
- Final Semester Certificate
- College leaving Certificate (of student leaves in mid-session)
- Certificate of having appeared in the University Examination.

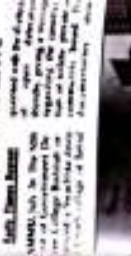
