**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN

PSPS Govt. College for women Gandhinagar Jammu (J&K) and Govt. - F. To guide and conduct internship programs for students.
- G. To train the students on emerging technologies in the field of teaching learning in order to bridge gaps in skill courses and make them ready for 2^{1st} century challenges.
- H. Consultation and support in development of IT based infrastructure and teaching labs.


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Operational Aspects:

This agreement is an understanding between these two institutions to facilitate each other in the above referred areas and the detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above, will be separately determined and agreed upon by both institutions.

These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity and faculty members responsible for its implementation of both educational institutions. In addition, the terms and conditions for organizing such programs and participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between the two parties.

This MOU shall remain in force for a period of two years from the date it is signed by the representatives of Govt. College for women Gandhinagar, Jammu and Govt. Degree College, Bishnah, Jammu. It may further be extended or amended within the written agreement of both parties.




