




# Poem Recitation Competition


















# Slogan writing competition

The program started with the plantation drive. The chief guest on the occasion was Principal of the College Dr. Anuradha Pandoh whereas the guest of honour were Mr. Rakeshwar Rana, Range Officer, Forest Range, Bahu, Jammu and Mr. Pawan Sharma, Range Officer, Forest Range, Kalidhar, Akhnoor. The welcome note was delivered by Dr. Suman Bala sharma, Convener, Ecoclub. The jury members for the evaluation of the seminar were Prof. Archana Bakshi, Dr. Asha Singh and Dr. Ratika Sharma. The first prize was secured by vivek dogra of BSc. Sem-1, second and third prize were bagged by Priya choudhary and Roshni Kumari of BSc. Sem-1 respectively where as consolation prize was given to Komal charak of BSc sem-1.
- Dr. Sheetu Raina (HOD Zoology) helped students in identifying the faunal components of these wetlands. During the survey, she emphasized that these wetlands are a rich source of local fish fauna, chironomous, tadpoles and young frogs. Moreover, these wetlands provide a congineal habitat for insects (viz. butterflies, dragonflies, beetles), birds (Ducks, kingfisher, egrets, water fowl) etc. which further add to the biological importance of these wetlands. Mr. Rakeshwar Rana, Range Officer, Forest Range, Bahu, Jammu also appreciated the effort and assured for all possible help in future endeavors.
